

<p>English Narrative Poetry - reading and commenting on a range of narrative poems, discussing effective poetic devices and exploring meaning through performance. We will imitate, innovate and invent poetry, until we are ready to produce our own poems for our Passion Play. Guided Reading - reading a range of international poetry and exploring the impact of similes, metaphors, personification, precisely chosen adjectives, rhyme and rhythm on the reader or audience. Understanding how performance can add meaning to a poem. Grammar - continuing to learn the perfect tenses, showing character through dialogue in narrative, varying sentence type and word order for effect.</p>	<p>History & Geography The history of our local church, from Saxon times to the present day - we will focus on how the architecture has changed, how we find out about history from clues left behind and other sources, and how it relates to other significant buildings and landmarks in Wantage. In Geography we will use and compare old and new maps to find out how Wantage has changed over time, learn the 8 compass points, use 6 figure grid references, keys and symbols on maps, and even create our own personal maps of Wantage.</p>	<p>R.E. Christianity: Exploring the events of the Easter Week, the people involved and their motives and emotions, asking why and what if questions. We will try and understand the Christian beliefs about the impact of Jesus' actions, and the way these events affect modern Christians today.</p> <hr/> <p>Science Following the huge success, but also steep learning curve, of the child-led investigations last term, children will have a further opportunity to conduct their own science experiment with an (Easter) egg theme. Children will be working towards their Science End of Year Expectations - working scientifically.</p>	<p>Maths Fractions - Our main focus this term will be on fractions, we will be learning to recognise and convert mixed number and improper fractions. As well as investigating equivalence in fractions with different denominators that share a common multiple, we will learn how to multiply fractions by a whole number. We will also be developing our understanding of percentages and decimals, including decimal and percentage equivalents to fractions.</p>	<p>PE The children will be focussing on rugby - working as a team, passing skills.
