Help Raise Money by Recycling Textiles

"Recycle with Michael" is The Salvation Army's Clothing Collection Scheme. The textile bank near the front of the school can be used to donate quality used textile items that then stock Salvation Army shops. Good quality items can be bagged and placed in the textile bank at the front of the school.



Donated items raise 20p per kilo of textiles and £100's have already been raised to help fund projects for the school. So why not sort out all those old handbags, shoes and any outfits languishing in the ironing basket to help fund special projects for our children.

The scheme accepts the following items in small tied plastic bags:

- Quality adult and children's clothing
- Handbags, bags, ties & belts & bras
- Soft Toys
- Paired shoes (tied together)
- Quality household textiles including towels, bed linen, curtains, blankets



Unwanted school uniform can be handed in at the school office for resale by the Friends'.

We cannot accept:

- Workwear / uniforms with school logos or company logos
- Duvets of any type
- Carpets nor Rugs
- Pillows nor cushions
- Rags, soiled nor wet clothing

Please don't leave black sacks next to the bank as if they get wet they cannot be used!
