### Appendix 1

#### The school community 2016/17

The percentage of pupils who have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the past six years is 15% compared to 26% nationally.

The percentage of pupils from ethnic minority backgrounds is 14% compared to 32% nationally.

The percentage of pupils who speak English as an additional language is 7% compared to 20% nationally.

The percentage of pupils who have special educational needs or are disabled is 12% compared to 13% nationally.

49% of our pupils are girls in line with the national figure of 49%.

No pupils have been permanently excluded during this period.

There were no recorded bullying incidents during this period.

Our workforce is 4.75 (FTE) males and 43.15 (FTE) females.

### Appendix 2

#### Equality Objectives 2017/2018

- To narrow the gap between disadvantage pupils and their peers in reading, writing and maths throughout the school
- To promote tolerance and respect across the curriculum in relation to behavior and diversity
- To reduce the number of FTEs for disadvantaged pupils, through the work of Individual Behaviour Support Plans (IBPs)
