

## Teaching Assistant

We have a Teaching Assistant post available from September 2018. The post is for 30 hours per week during term time. The salary is Grade 4 Point 11 (full time equivalent £17,007) pro rata to reflect hours and the term time nature of the post (£11,485). Applicants must have a minimum of two A-levels, BTEC equivalent or appropriate previous experience in the role.

The role will include supporting small groups of SEN students within the Learning Support Base. The learning support may be focussed on literacy, numeracy or personal life skills. There will also be work within the mainstream classroom to support SEN learners. You will be part of a dynamic, enthusiastic and supportive culture which values all students and staff.

There are opportunities to work with different age groups and Special Educational Needs, including working with students with Emotional and Behavioural difficulties.
