Year 2 Parent Information on the Curriculum (Terms 3 - 4)

English

In English we will be reading the book 'The Bear and the Piano'. We will be developing our existing knowledge on expanded noun phrases and writing our own story. We will then be writing a non-chronological report on our favourite animals. In Term 4, we will start with writing a setting description then move on to a character description focusing on the text 'The Sun King'. Children will be drawing on their prior knowledge of expanded noun phrases, similes and adjectives to bring a character and setting to life.

Maths

Term Three will begin with a focus on Money learning about pounds and pence. We will then move onto calculating multiplication and division specifically focusing on the 2,5 and 10 times tables. To help with this, we encourage the children to be going onto Numberbots and Times Table Rock Stars as regularly as possible. Our last unit in term 4 will be measuring space.

Computing

Year Two will be learning about how music makes us feel. Children will learn rhythm, tempo and patterns. They will also create their own digital piece of music.

Geography

In this unit, we will be look specifically at world maps, oceans and exploring any questions children have about the world around them. Our big question 'Where does the land meet the sea?'

History
