English

Term 3

Maths

In Term 3 and 4 we are focusing on: Calculating Fractions, Decimals and Percentages Multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000

Solving problems with ratio and proportion

Using algebra to solve simple formulae

Calculating space including volume

Interpreting pie charts and line graphs Calculating the mean as an average

We continuing with our daily fluency sessions to recap essential knowledge. We are also continuing with our TT Rockstars so do encourage your child to go on at home.

Computing

In term 3 we are looking at spreadsheets, using them to answer questions and organise and calculate data. In term 4 we will be designing and coding a project that captures input from a physical device.
