Year 3 Parent Information on the Curriculum (Terms 1-2)

English

In Term 1, Year 3 are taking inspiration from 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. They will be learning how to use ambitious vocabulary, paragraphs, noun phrases and adverbials to engage their readers and write their own portal stories.

In Term 2, Year 3 will be learning about inclusivity and equality in their local area. We will be reading a range of books such as 'All are welcome here' and 'Along came a different'.

Maths

Year 3 will be beginning the year with *Place Value*. Building on their previous understanding of numbers up to 100, we will be exploring the value of numbers up to 1000. We will then begin out work on *addition and subtraction*, exploring many different mental and written methods which can help us alongside a range of resources. Finally, Year 3 will be exploring <u>money</u>. As this can be a difficult unit for some children, we would appreciate any parental help at home in regards to learning the different coins as well as adding and subtracting coins.
